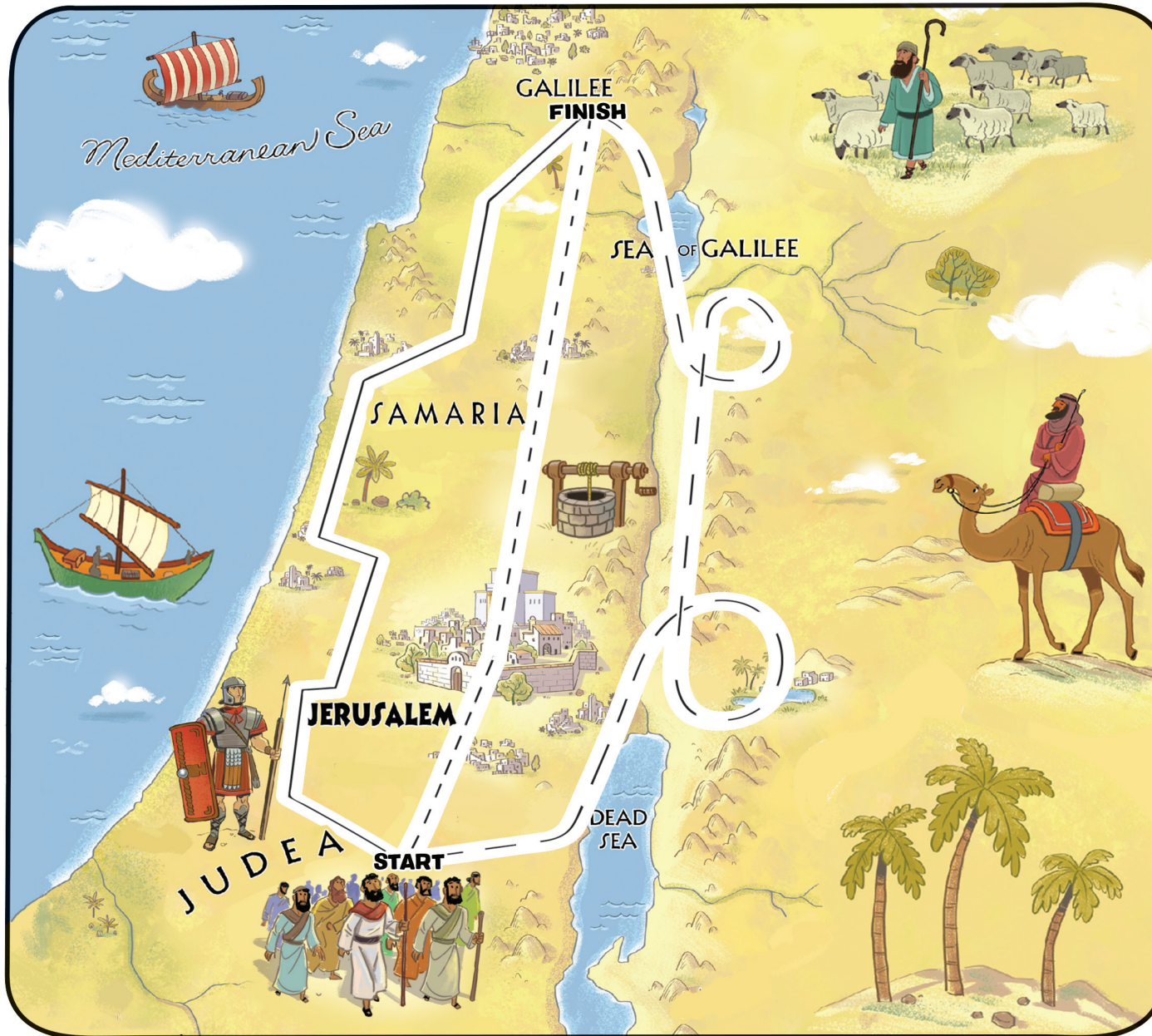

Jesus and the Samaritan Woman

BIBLE STORY:

- Jesus asked a Samaritan woman at a well to give Him a drink.
- Jesus told the woman that He was the Messiah.
- The woman told other people about Jesus and they believed.
- Jesus loves all people.

KEY PASSAGE: John 3:16

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- What makes people special? People are special because God made us in His own image.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Why was the Samaritan woman surprised Jesus talked to her?
- What is the living water Jesus told the woman He could give her?
- What happened when the woman told the people in her town about Jesus?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Print John 4:13-14 on labels to put on sealed water bottles. Distribute the water at a park or playground.
- Set up a lemonade stand in your neighborhood to raise money to drill a well in another country.

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- How can we be filled with "living water"?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- If weather permits, play with your family in the yard with a sprinkler. Talk to your kids about the way the water fills the hose before shooting out of the sprinkler. Ask them to think of ways to "shoot out" God's love onto others.



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
