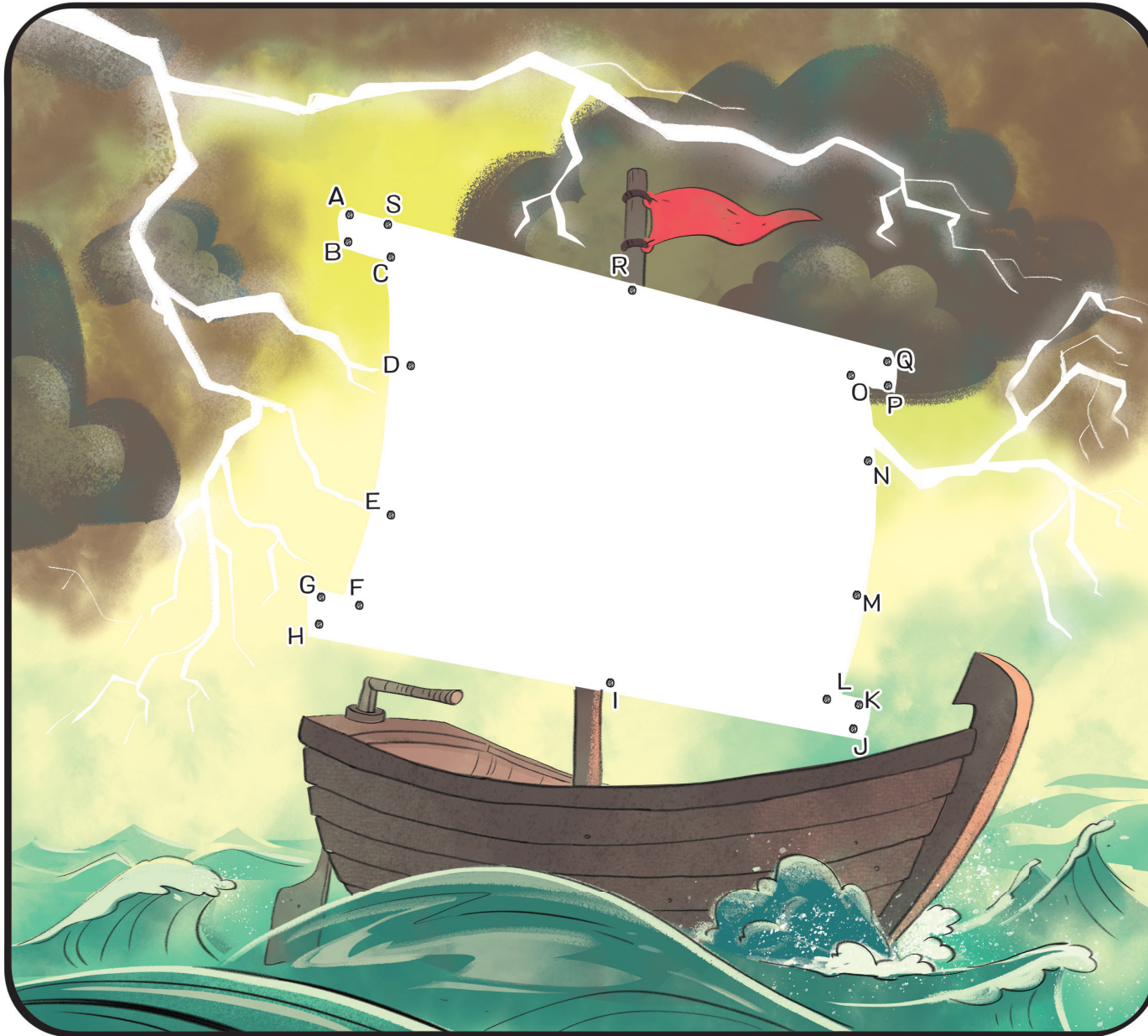


Connect the Dots

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Jesus fell asleep as He and His disciples were in a boat on the sea.
- All of a sudden, a storm came.
- The disciples were scared and woke up Jesus, asking Him to save them.
- Jesus spoke and calmed the storm.

KEY PASSAGE: Psalm 40:5

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- Why did Jesus perform miracles?
Jesus performed miracles to show He is the Son of God.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- What did Jesus say to His friends after He calmed the storm?
- What are some things that make you afraid?
- How did Jesus show His disciples that He is the Lord?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Set up a sprinkler and a small wading pool. Invite friends over to play out the Bible story.
- Calm nerves from stormy weather this week by reminding children that Jesus is Lord of all creation.

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Jesus and His disciples got into a boat to cross the Sea of Galilee
- A violent storm came on them, and Jesus was asleep.
- The disciples cried out in fear and woke Jesus.
- Jesus calmed a storm to show the disciples He is God.

KEY PASSAGE: Psalm 40:5

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- Why did Jesus perform miracles?
Jesus performed miracles to glorify God, to show He is the Son of God, and to care for people.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- What situations make you feel afraid?
- How can you trust Jesus through scary situations?
- Why is it good to know Jesus is God?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Take family a trip to a lake or pool. Spend the day playing in the water. Discuss the Bible story and remind your kids that Jesus is trustworthy. He is more powerful than anything or anyone else.
